In September 2025, the Honourable Uzoma Asagwara, Minister of Health, visited Ste. Anne Hospital to discuss the possibility of designating our facility as a regional health facility. The Honourable Wab Kinew, Premier of Manitoba, stated his support for this initiative by sending an official letter to the mayor of Sainte-Anne, Mr. Yvan St-Vincent.

The provincial government has also announced the creation of a working committee to study the progress of the project. This announcement represents a major milestone and is great news for our community. Our elected municipal officials from the surrounding municipalities, accompanied by the support of the AMBM (the voice of Manitoba's bilingual municipalities), have been instrumental in the project's progress to this stage.

Thank you for your continued support of the Ste. Anne Hospital Fund. The Fund will continue its efforts to actively support this initiative, which aims to strengthen the services offered to the public.

## Did you know:

Ste. Anne Hospital heliport must be inspected every day of the week, as well as prior to each landing of the Stars helicopter.

Transport Canada conducts an inspection of the heliport every few years and it always receives praise from inspectors, ranking it among the best heliports in Canada. For example: During the last inspection, a Transport Canada inspector stated that "the Ste-Anne heliport is a model for all of Canada to follow."
